Rotate them together until the irregular v-shaped parts are on the inside of the ring. | 18. When you have completed the rotation, be sure that the " $V$ "s are over the remaining bands. If you have a tight weave ring, you may want to leave this band loose, as the tight weave requires you to complete the next steps before it will fit into place. | 19. Turn ring over and fit the " 1 " and " 5 " bands together (they also act as one). Rotate the bands together until the irregular $v$-shaped parts are on the inside of the ring and under bands " 2 " \& " 6 ". | 20. The last bands should fall into place. | 14.
